SUBJECT FIELDS AND MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED: (a) Social Science: A first Class Master's Degree in the subject field. (b) Dairy Technology: A first Class Master's Degree in the subject or Allied Fields. (c) Geo-Thermal Technology: A first Class Master's Degree in Geology or Geophysics.

AUSTRALIA
SUBJECT FIELDS AND MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: (a) Solar Energy (b) ...

ESSENTIAL EXPERIENCE: At least two years (a) teaching/research or practical experience or (b) higher studies/advanced work on 31st December, 1987 after acquiring the qualifications prescribed above.

AGE: Below 35 years on 1st August, 1988 (Preference will however, be given to

Crossed Postal Order of Rs. 5.00 [Rs. 12.25 only in the case of SC/ST and other Backward Class candidate, who must attach a certificate to the effect that they belong to one of these classes] payable to the Secretary, Ministry of Human Resource Development (Deptt. of Education), New Delhi. Applications which do not contain Postal Orders will not be considered. (7) Applications of candidates who are abroad will not be considered. (8) Only Postal Orders issued after the date on which the advertisement was published in newspapers will be accepted.
